Glossary of terms note have noted inclusion of Samoan but unsure about non-inclusion of the other Pacific Island The Glossary of terms will require education through nursing education schools and Health Stake Holders. Inclusion of Pacific Health Model knowledge would also strengthen the competencies.

We appreciate the competency and Pou differences between the Enrolled and Registered nursing competencies. The proposed competencies for the enrolled nursing offer clarity on the role and expectations and enable each registered enrolled nurse to be held accountable for their professional nursing practice.
